

New venues in the frame



SIX new venues have joined the ever-growing Fringe this year - proving yet again that Artweek reaches out to places that other exhibitions do not reach.

The organising committee are grateful to the galleries, shops, restaurants and others who have hosted fringe displays year after year.

And thanks also go out to those offering exhibition space for the first time this year, including J Brindon Addy Butchers, just a short drive from Holmfirth on the B6106 Dunford Road.

The shop at the Old Farmhouse, Flowery Fields, Hade Edge will host a display of stoneware by Artweek stalwart Richard Raby. His *Hare No Evil* is pictured above.

Another addition for 2008 is the Mezze Bar Restaurant, 9 Huddersfield Road, Holmfirth, where Richard's son Liam Raby has a photography exhibition.

Three of the town's most popular leisure facilities are also joining the Fringe.

They are: the Old Bridge Hotel - showing paintings by Caro Ward; the Picturedrome cinema - metal sculpture by Mick Kirkby-Geddes and the 'Holme Valley Boys' - lantern slides; and CragRats Café Bar - digital prints by Christian Bailey. Rosalind Annis Studio, at Ingleside, Shaw Lane - displaying pastels, pottery and photographs - is a new location although certainly not a new name on the Artweek schedule.
